IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS KEY PASSAGE: HEBREWS 9:11-14

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage (Praise God for the heavenly tabernacle, that Jesus entered once for all; Praise God for the blood of the spotless lamb, Jesus)?

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

1. Vs. 11 starts out with the phrase, "But when Christ appeared..." What changed when Christ appeared?

2. The high priest entered the Most Holy Place once a year, but Jesus entered once for all. How did He secure an eternal redemption for us rather than the need for a "once a year" redemption?

3. In last week's passage (9:6-10) we saw details of how a human priest worked within the human tabernacle. This week (9:11-14) we are seeing how our divine High Priest (Jesus) works within the glorious heavenly tabernacle.
