IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

KEY PASSAGE: HEBREWS 9:15-22

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage (Look to Jesus, your hope of eternal life because of His death on the cross; See how the Old Testament law was a shadow of Jesus, our Lamb of God, and His sacrifice for us.)?

1. In vs. 15, what is the "therefore" there for?
2. Vs. 15 has a purpose statement using the words "so that." What is the purpose of Jesus being the mediator of a new covenant?
3. In vs. 18, what's the "therefore" there for? Why does this matter?

4. How does a person who is deeply grateful for Jesus' sacrifice act toward God and others? How does a person who takes it for granted act?
5. Please describe everything that Moses had to sprinkle with blood in order to purify it. How are each of those things represented in Jesus' shed blood?
6. How does Hebrews 9:15-22 reinforce Ephesians 2:8-9, "For it is by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast"?
