## **IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS**

**KEY PASSAGE: 1 PETER 5:1-8** 

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage? A godly church will have elders that shepherd the flock willingly, lovingly, and gently; A godly church will have members that live humbly, dependently, and watchfully.

1. Vs. 1-3 give a charge to the elders of the church in how to care for the church.

#### INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

a. What is the command given in vs. 2?

. Who owns the flock? How does that impact the role of the elder?
. Please describe the ways the elder is to shepherd the flock, and give the opposite meaning s well.
. Vs. 3 says that elders need to be an example to the flock, and vs. 5 says that the younger eople should be subject to the elders. How does the example of the elder impact the heart one young? Why does God expect the young to be subject to the elder?

3. From vs. 6-8 ~
a. How will humility (or lack of humility) impact the way we handle the devil's attacks?
b. What place does trust have in our submission to the Lord, as well as our submission to the elders?
c. What is God's role and what is the devil's role? Why do you think it's easy to get the roles of the Lord and the devil mixed up?
