2. Please note the use of the words “the flesh” in vs. 11 and 14. What difference do you see between the flesh of Gentiles/Jews vs. Jesus’ flesh?

3. In Matthew 16:18 Jesus says, “On this rock I will build My church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.” Please look at Ephesians 2:11-22 to see how God is building His church. Please explain the specific phrases you see here as God’s role in building the church.

IMPACT GROUP QUESTIONS

4. Ephesians 2:15 says that God “abolished the law of commandments expressed in ordinances.” Why is that important for building the church?

5. When you see how we as Gentiles are described in this passage before salvation vs. after salvation, how are you impacted in the way you approach God and in how you view relationships with other believers?

6. Please read Ephesians 2:21-22. Please describe your view of what the actions, character traits, and attitudes are for those who are “growing into a holy temple” and are “being built together into a dwelling place for God.”
