3. Please compare Proverbs 3:7 with Isaiah 43:1, "But now thus says the Lord, He who created you, O Jacob, He who formed you, O Israel: 'Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name, you are Mine.'" How is fearing the Lord different from being afraid?

4. Please look back at the story from Mark 4:35-41. How were the disciples leaning on their own understanding?

5. How were they acknowledging Jesus in Mark 4:35-41?

6. How did Jesus bring the disciples healing to their flesh and refreshment to their bones?
