2. Please compare what the servant's said about the centurion with what the centurion said about himself. How do you think Jesus would have responded if the centurion said the same thing about himself that his servants said about him? What does this tell you about the connection between humility and faith?

3. Please list the things God does in this passage and explain how Jesus fulfills each of these things.

4. Please read Psalm 146:5. Why is hoping in the Lord important? In what things do we tend to put our hope instead?

5. Looking back at the things you saw about Jesus in this passage, how does hoping in other things compare to what God can do?

CHALLENGE THE WILL
