1. What attributes or promises of God do you see in Romans 4:13-25?

2. What promise was given to Abraham, and what is significant about the promise to Abraham coming from faith rather than the law (vs. 13-15)?

3. How is Abraham an example of God's power working even in our weaknesses?

4. Please compare Romans 4:20-21 with Hebrews 11:17-19. How does the passage in Hebrews give evidence to Abraham's display of faith in God's promises?

5. How does our faith in God's promises affect our obedience?

6. Please explain the following from vs. 23-25:

a. "Counted to us who believe"

b. "Delivered up for our trespasses"

c. "Raised for our justification"

7. In what ways do we sometimes try to justify ourselves?
