KEY PASSAGE: EXODUS 17:8-16

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage?

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

Please read Psalm 105:1-7

1. Please explain all the commands in this passage. How does obedience to these commands affect perspective in our circumstances?

2. What words or phrases in this passage point to our need for prayer, and what insight do they give you into how we pray?

3. Vs. 3 says, "Glory in His holy name." How can we know if we're glorying in His name vs. glorying in our own?

4. The word "seek" is repeated three times in vs. 3-4. (Repetition in scripture means it's really important.) What importance do you think this word holds in our relationship with God and others?

5. The world rewrites vs. 4 and replaces the words “Lord” and “His” with things other than the Lord, what are some of those and what is the actual end result of that path? (i.e. “Seek _____ and _____ strength; seek _____ continually.”)

6. What are some “wondrous works” (vs. 5) that you’ve seen the Lord do in your own life?

7. What evidence do you see in this passage that points to us partnering in prayer? Why is partnering in prayer important?

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what actions/focus do you need to pursue in order to draw closer to the Lord (i.e. Work to honor the Lord while always bathing it in prayer, partner together in the work of prayer, remember all the answers to prayer throughout life)?
