KEY PASSAGE: LUKE 19:28-48

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage?

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

Please read Psalm 100

1. If you were at the scene in Luke 19, when Jesus was being praised, for what specific things in your life would you be praising Jesus?

2. In Psalm 100, what are the commands given? What are the “opposites” of the commands given? What are some reasons that we sometimes do the opposite of what this Psalm is calling us to do?

3. What reasons does Psalm 100 give for calling us to praise and thank the Lord?

4. Psalm 100:3 says, “We are His people and the sheep of His pasture.” How would a humble heart respond to this truth? How would a proud heart respond to this truth?

5. How does the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus prove out Psalm 100:5?

6. What attribute of God from this passage inspires your worship the most at this season of your life and why?

CHALLENGE THE WILL

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what actions/focus do you need to pursue in order to draw closer to the Lord (i.e. Authentic worship obeys Jesus fully; authentic worship rejoices and praises Jesus loudly; authentic worship hangs on every word of Jesus)?
