KEY PASSAGE: ACTS 10:34-48

Opening: What truths impacted you most from the sermon/passage?

INFORM THE HEAD / STIR THE HEART

Please read Acts 2:22-41

1. What truths about Jesus from vs. 22-24 do we need to grasp in order to protect ourselves from pride?

2. Why do you think Peter repeated the statement that these people before him crucified Jesus? How could he say that they had crucified Jesus when they weren't Roman soldiers?

3. How are we guilty of Jesus' crucifixion?

4. What evidence from vs. 37 shows that the people believed they were guilty of Jesus' death?

5. What point is Peter trying to make in quoting David's words in Psalm 16 (see especially Acts 2:29-35)?

6. How does pride prevent us from seeing our need to repent and be baptized?

7. What truths from this passage give you reason to worship Christ?

8. If you were one of the people who heard Peter's words, what reason would you give for wanting to be baptized?

9. How can you practically take a stand for Jesus in your present circumstances?

CHALLENGE THE WILL

Based on what you learned from the study, or read in the passage, what actions/focus do you need to pursue in order to draw closer to the Lord and to seek restoration in relationships with others in your life (i.e. Grasp the truth about Jesus; Hear Him! Truly Hear Him! Take a public stand with Him in baptism)?
