- Focus on the failures of others \(\nsigma\) Overwhelmed with a sense of their own spiritual need
- A critical, fault-finding spirit; look at V Compassionate; can forgive much everyone else's faults with a microscope, but their own with a telescope
 - because they know how much they have been forgiven

 - Self-righteous; look down on others ▼ Esteem all others better than themselves
 - Independent, self-sufficient spirit ▼ Have a dependent spirit; recognize
 - their need for others

 - Have to prove that they are right ▼ Willing to yield the right to be right
 - Claim rights; have a demanding spirit ▼ Yield their rights; have a meek spirit
 - Self-protective of their time, their rights, ▼ Self-denying and their reputation
 - Desire to be served ▼ Motivated to serve others

 - Desire to be a success \(\nbbeau\) Motivated to be faithful and to make others a success

 - appreciated
 - Have a drive to be recognized and \checkmark Have a sense of their own unworthiness; thrilled that God would use them at all
- Wounded when others are promoted and ▼ Eager for others to get the credit; they are overlooked
 - rejoice when others are lifted up
 - ministry/church is privileged to have me and my gifts"; think of what they can do for God

Concerned with being real; what matters to them is not what others think but what God knows; are willing to die to their own reputation

Find it difficult to share their spiritual need with others

Willing to be open and transparent with others as God directs

Want to be sure that no one finds \textstyle out when they have sinned; their instinct is to cover up

Once broken, don't care who knows or who finds out; are willing to be exposed because they have nothing to lose

Have a hard time saying, "I was wrong; will you please forgive me?"

Quick to admit failure and to seek forgiveness when necessary

Tend to deal in generalities when ▼ confessing sin

Able to acknowledge specifics when confessing their sin

Concerned about the consequences

Grieved over the cause, the root of of their sin

Remorseful over their sin, sorry that they got found out or caught

Truly, genuinely repentant over their sin, evidenced in the fact that they forsake that sin

Wait for the other to come and v ask forgiveness when there is a misunderstanding or conflict in a relationship

Take the initiative to be reconciled when there is misunderstanding or conflict in relationships; they race to the cross; they see if they can get there first, no matter how wrong the other may have been

Compare themselves with others \textstyle and feel worthy of honor

Compare themselves to the holiness of God and feel a desperate need for His mercy

Blind to their true heart condition ▼ Walk in the light

repent of

Don't think they have anything to ▼ Realize they have need of a continual heart attitude of repentance

are sure that everyone else does

Don't think they need revival, but ▼ Continually sense their need for a fresh encounter with God and for a fresh filling of His Holy Spirit
